Norwood International High School proudly offers three special interest programs for 2024 year 7 students from both within and outside our school zone:

STEM Program

The STEM program extends, challenges and enriches students' understanding of their world through the development of STEM capabilities and the integration of authentic STEM experiences.

Italian Immersion Program

The Italian Immersion program engages students as global citizens in a unique integrated Italian and Humanities Program, developing higher levels of language competence and enhancing their intercultural capabilities.

Rowing Program

The Rowing program engages students in fitness and conditioning, team building, competition and racing strategies. The course is offered as a physical education subject in years 7-10 where students have the opportunity to develop their rowing skills as well as compete in regattas.

Norwood International High School enjoys specialist middle and senior schooling facilities and structures that support the unique development of adolescents and their preferred pathways.

Middle Schooling for Years 7 to 9

Our middle schooling practices and specialist learning environment foster a culture of engagement, connectedness and personalisation. Middle school learners in years 7-9 join a Connect Group and are supported by a small, specialised team of dedicated teachers within their learning community.

Students undertake a variety of subjects and experiences within the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IBMYP). This learning promotes curiosity, collaboration, global understanding and intellectual stretch, empowering our students to grow both personally and academically.

In weekly Connect sessions, the dedicated mentor teacher delivers an engaging, structured program that supports our students to develop self-confidence, build positive social skills and achieve success in their learning.

Our staff understand the complex adolescent milestones and actively work in partnership with families to maximise student engagement and achievement.

As part of our transition program new year 7 students enjoy transition days and camps promoting positive relationships and school connectedness.

Senior Schooling for Years 10 to 12

Within our dedicated senior school we build on independent learning and prepare students for further education, training or employment in a globally connected world.

Senior students may study either the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) or the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)*. They choose from an extensive curriculum catering for a range of preferred futures and specialised learning.

Norwood International High School graduates have a reputation for achieving excellence in their studies with outstanding results and move successfully into their preferred university, vocational or tertiary pathways.

Once again, 100% of our graduates achieved their South Australian Certificate of Education in 2022.

*Norwood International High School is one of five Government Schools authorised to deliver the IBDP.
