- 2. Create an account using your email or mobile number- a link or verification code will be sent to you
- 3. Input your details and continue
- 4. Enter student's Learnlink email (if known). If student email is not known click "Not Sure" and find Norwood International High School and search for student's name
- 5. Add your student/s and select their booklists
- 6. Select items to purchase from the booklists and check out using the secure payment gateway
